

How to Care for Your Oiled Parquet Flooring

Material Characteristics

Oiled parquet stands out for its natural appearance and the possibility of targeted refreshing. The oiled surface penetrates the wood and protects it from within without sealing the pores.

Wood reacts to climatic fluctuations. These characteristics are typical of the material and do not represent a quality defect.

Indoor Climate

An indoor temperature of 20 to 22 degrees Celsius with a relative humidity of 40 to 50 percent is ideal, with a minimum of 35 percent. On heated substructures, the surface temperature must not exceed 26 degrees Celsius. During the heating season, we recommend using humidifiers.

Initial Treatment After Installation

After installation, we recommend an initial treatment with a suitable parquet oil. This additionally protects the joints and optimally saturates the surface.

Regular Cleaning

Vacuum regularly or dry mop. If necessary, clean with a slightly damp cloth using water and a re greasing wood floor soap. Depending on wear, re oil in good time to maintain protection and the silky matte finish.

Recommended

- *Dirt trap mats in entrance areas*
- *Felt pads under furniture*
- *Plant pots with saucers*
- *Regular re oiling according to manufacturer specifications*

Avoid

- *Microfiber cloths*
- *Abrasive cleaners*
- *Steam cleaners*
- *Wet cleaning with standing water*
- *Cleaning machines*
